In a live interview with Ms. Rachel Flor, Executive Director of the John F. Kennedy Library Foundation, Dr. Fredrik Logevall, Laurence D. Belfer Professor of International Affairs at the Harvard Kennedy School and Professor of History in the Faculty of Arts & Sciences, Harvard University, will discuss the important work of preserving President Kennedy's legacy.

Their topics of discussion will range from the lens that President Kennedy's life offers on US and global history of the time, to key elements of President Kennedy's development as a leader, and to ways in which President Kennedy fostered Americans' civic engagement.

They will also look at Dr. Logevall's research and writing process for his recent biography, *JFK: Coming of Age in the American Century, 1917-1956*, that has a second volume forthcoming.
