### **ARRIVAL AND PARKING**

### Parking Made Easy

Lot 1 is reserved for VIP and accessible parking. Friendly staff, county police, and crossing guards will guide you. For extra convenience, golf carts will help transport guests who need assistance.

### **Meeting Spot**

Pick a designated spot—like your car or a special spot on campus—where you and your loved ones can regroup after the ceremony.

### **Robing Up**

Begin at 8 a.m. in the main gym of the Physical Education Building. Leave valuables safely with your guests or in your car, and enjoy the process as you pair up in alphabetical order and prepare to walk together.

### FOR YOUR FAMILY AND GUESTS

### **Gathering Point**

Your guests are invited to head straight to the commencement tent, where friendly ushers will help guide everyone. Guests should be seated by 10:20 a.m. to ensure the aisles are clear during the ceremony.

### **Ticket Check**

All guests need a ticket (to be scanned at the entrance) to enjoy the celebration under the tent.

### PLAN TO HAVE A GREAT TIME

### What To Wear

Choose comfortable shoes and neatly pressed attire. After the ceremony, feel free to let your personality shine by displaying honor cords and PTK stoles outside your gown.

### Rain or Shine

The ceremony will go on—rain or shine—and the College will provide free rain ponchos, if needed.

### What To Leave Behind

Alcoholic beverages, tobacco, and electronic cigarettes are not permitted at the ceremony or on the property.

### A Note on Accessories

Leave strollers, large bags, umbrellas, balloons behind to keep the focus on celebration and safety. Feel free to leave strollers at the secured area of the commencement tent near the guest entrance.

### THE CEREMONY EXPERIENCE

### Processional and Presentation

- The processional begins at 10 a.m. Graduates will walk in pairs down the main aisle toward the stage.
- When it's your turn to proceed to the stage, give the card bearing your name to the reader at the stage.
- As you proceed across the stage, pause to enjoy a photo with Dr. Williams, then follow the usher's instructions to a second photo area before returning to your seat.

### Recessional

- After induction into the Alumni Association, a wait your turn in the recessional, following the usher's signals to exit gracefully in pairs.
- Graduates will follow the platform guests, administrators, faculty, staff, and deans.


### **Extra Viewing Areas**
