What is the MC Biotech Boot Camp?

- Tuition free, four-week (64 hours) rigorous hands-on biotech training of industry-standard skills for individuals interested in a career in biotechnology. (You need no prior biotech experience)
- Sponsored by a State of Maryland EARN grant (Employment Advancement Right Now)
- A collaborative effort between WorkSource Montgomery and Montgomery College to prepare workers for the biotechnology industry



Who is Eligible?

Applicants must:

- Be at least age 18
- Be a Maryland resident
- Be legally eligible to work in the US
- Be unemployed or underemployed
- Have had their employment status affected by COVID – this includes a job loss, reduction in hours, unstable employment, or challenges finding new employment
- Have the personal infrastructure (transportation, childcare) for program commitment
- Being on time and fully attending all classes/training workshops



What are the Expectations?



- Adherence to safety protocols
- Proper gowning in laboratories during a typical work day.
- Keen attention to detail and preciseness
- Methodical practices & carefully following of directions/ Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs)
- Exceptional observation and documentation skills

What are the benefits?



- Industry-reviewed lectures and hands-on laboratory workshop.
- Intensive skill-emphasized training potentially prepares individuals for entry-level biomanufacturing jobs.
- Resume writing/interview preparation workshop readies participants for future interviews with potential employers.
- Successful boot camp graduates will have their resumes presented to local biotechnology companies for review and possible interview opportunities.
- Tuition free training.

What are the steps to apply?

Two Simple Steps:

1. Complete and submit a pre-registration form online with your resume.
2. Watch for an email request to review your application via a Zoom meeting with our team.
